DIAGNOSIS

A comprehensive diagnostic library of known diseases and treatments are provided with iDATAFLOW. Diagnosis information is recorded by the Herd Manager or veterinarian against each cow in the *Cow Card*. The diagnosis form has fields for recording the person's name, diagnosis type, date and time the diagnosis took place. The diagnosis can be permanent or set to expire automatically.

- Diagnosis data for entire herd
- Mastitis incidence report
- Drenching summary



DISEASE

iDATAFLOW has powerful data mining capabilities. Couple this with sophisticated sensors located at the milking point and on the cow, iDATAFLOW can produce reports of cows that are potentially at risk of disease. For example, cows that fail to reach the expected milk production level after calving and have lower than expected rumination maybe suspected for Ketosis and need inspection. A decrease in yield and rumination with an increase in conductivity points to mastitis.

TREATMENTS

The iDATAFLOW treatments database contains hundreds of registered animal health drugs that are commonly given to your livestock. This saves a lot of time when entering treatments whether it is on a per cow basis or by group. The drug that is used is recorded on the *Cow Card* and stays with the cow for life so that you can check treatment history.
