



REMOTE DATA ACCESS



DATA TERMINALS

Up to 5 Data Terminals can be installed in the parlour or around the farm for remote Data Access. This enables you the flexibility to enter *Cow Events, Treatments and Alerts*. You can look up lifetime information of the cow including important dates around calving and mating. You can also look up *Production* information for the current milking, previous sessions and the entire lactation.

Cows can be *Sorted* quickly using the *Data Terminal* by adding a sorting status or adding a predetermined alert that has a sorting status attached.

If cows do not have electronic identification tags or collars, the cow number can be entered into the system including the milking point she is in and the yield information will be attached to that cow in the iDATAFLOW software. This is useful for parlours without electronic ID or cows that have not been read correctly.

LCD DISPLAY & WARNING LAMPS

An LCD display can be installed in the milking parlour to alert the operators of cows that need attention during milking time. The messages that are displayed are from alerts that are entered at the iDATAFLOW Software, Data Terminals or Events that occur during milking.

A cow that does not reach an expected yield for the milking or if she kicks the cluster off is alerted to the operator by a flashing lamp. The Milking Point number, Cow Number and Alert are displayed on screen.

TEXT MESSAGING

iDATAFLOW has the option to Text Message a summary of the milking to a number of preset mobile phone numbers. This allows you to monitor your farming operation remotely.

TXT MSG DETAILS

- Milking start and finish time
- Yield for milking and total for day
- Average yield
- Number of cows at milking
- Number of milking points with abnormal milking termination
- Number of cows on-heat



SATELLITE LINK

Milfos recommend that a broadband internet connection is established at the parlour for remote access. This allows viewing of the milking remotely, online diagnostics and remote back up.
